Session 2: Conflict of Interests

Roleplay Prompts

Your family just moved into a new house. There are three rooms available for you, your brother and sister, but one is larger than the others and has a bigger closet. Your sister has the most clothes and insists she needs the room. Your brother thinks he should get the room because he's the oldest. You want the extra space for your drum set. It bothered everyone when you practiced in the dining room. Your parents told you to work it out amongst yourselves.

This month, your school is engaging students in an anti-drug campaign. You and Eduardo have been chosen to create a large banner to be hung in the school's main hallway. Eduardo wants to draw a series of student portraits, each with their own drug awareness slogan. You don't like drawing and would rather use the banner to explain the school's campaign in large block letters.

You've recently become friends with Kelsey and sent her a friend request online. You really like Kelsey in person, but online she's a bit much. She likes and comments on almost everything you post, and some of her comments are inappropriate. You've grown very irritated and you're worried that your parents and other friends will disapprove of what they see on your profile.

Session 4: The Responsible Decision-Making Model Roleplay Prompts

You are in the cafeteria and see someone sitting alone at one table, and your group of friends at another. There is only one seat at your friends' table. What do you do?

It is a windy day and you are out walking. You see a \$5 bill on the ground. It's not yours and someone might come back for it, but with the weather it might blow away anyway. What do you do?

You need to catch the school bus to meet your younger brother at home when his own bus arrives. You realize it's try outs day for the team you really want to join at school. If you leave you will miss your chance to try out, but if you stay your brother is alone. What do you do?

In art class, you rush to fill up your paint jar from the larger bucket because you are excited to paint. A few minutes later your teacher is upset. The bucket spilled on someone's art and she wants to know who didn't twist the lid back on. There is a rule that you get lunch detention if you don't take care of the paint. You think you forgot to put it back the right way when you rushed. What do you do?

Walking home from school you know you are supposed to go straight home so you won't be late getting ready for soccer. Your friend is walking with you and starts to cry, asking if you can stay and talk. What do you do?

You are in the hallway and hear a group of older students walk past someone younger and call her a name. She is upset but doesn't say anything as the older students walk away. What do you do?

Your friend forgot their snack at home. Sharing snacks is not allowed because someone might have an allergy to a certain food. Your friend is hungry and says they don't have an allergy. Your snack is big. What do you do?

You are taking a quiz for school online. You realize you left open a window with your notes on another tab. If you don't close it and someone notices, they might think you are cheating. If you do open it, you might see the answers and accidentally cheat. What do you do?

You are walking in front of your school and suddenly hear a crunch under your shoe. You look down and see a pair of broken glasses in the mulch. You must have stepped on them. No one saw, and no one is looking for glasses yet, but someone probably will be soon. What do you do?
